RESPONSIVE READING: Acts 10:34-43, Peter's sermon to the Gentiles

READER: Trudy Pickersgill

One: Speaking to Cornelius, and his relatives and close friends, Peter said:

All: I now see how true it is that God shows no favouritism, but that in every nation, those who are godfearing and do what is right are embraced by God.

One: God's word was sent to the people of Israel, that they might receive the good news of peace through Christ Jesus, who is Lord of all. I need not tell you what happened throughout Judea, starting from Galilee after the baptism proclaimed by John.

All: We know about Jesus of Nazareth, how God anointed him with the Holy Spirit and with power. He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the forces of evil, for God was with him. And we can bear witness to all that he did in the countryside of the nation and in Jerusalem.

One: He was put to death by hanging on a cross; but God raised him to life on the third day, and allowed him to appear, not to the whole people, but to witnesses whom God had chosen in advance – to us, who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead. God commanded us to proclaim him to the people, and affirm that he is the one who has been designated by God as judge of both the living and the dead.

All: It is to him all the prophets testify, declaring that everyone who trusts in him receives forgiveness of sins through his name.
